

Rats in the sewers and drains are a risk to your health!

The rats that live in the sewers and drains of our villages, towns and cities are shy, secretive and rarely seen. Rats are very intelligent, they breed very quickly when enough food is available and can act as carriers for fleas, parasites and numerous diseases. If you see rats, report exactly what you saw and where you saw them right away.

If they are on private land or in privately owned houses or flats, you must report it to the owner. The law states that property owners must take immediate steps to get rid of them and pay all the costs of pest control – so there's no cost to you.

As a public authority, we lay out rat poison in the city's sewers and drains. There will be no danger to you, your family, your pets or the environment. In the few cases that rat poison is laid out above ground, this is always clearly indicated by warning signs. By the way, rats are extremely cautious and the poisons used to kill them may take a couple of weeks to finish their work, so please be patient if you still see rats for a while.
